IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CARERS AT ST EUGENE'S PRIMARY SCHOOL

Please take the time to read all pages of this document carefully.

I am delighted to inform you that due to continued growth within the school we have employed an additional teacher for the year ahead. This is great news for everyone, it allows us to reduce class sizes and pupil: teacher ratio, manage workload and add to our existing skillset within the staff. WHEN WILL MY CHILD RETURN TO SCHOOL?

- <u>Children beginning P2-P7 will attend school on Friday 30th of August: 9.15am –</u> <u>11.30am for a transition morning</u>. There will be no transport or catering. *Children in these classes will require a mid-morning snack from our healthy breaks list.*
- <u>P1 will begin on Monday 2nd of September and will stay until 11am only for the first</u> week.

WHAT ARE THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR DROPPING OFF MY CHILD?

- Doors open at 9:00am, pupils should be on time for class starting at 9.15am. For entry before this time the Breakfast Club will be available from Monday 2nd of September from 8.15am in our mobile building at the cost of £1.
- Please do not park in the yellow box in front of the green gate.
- Children should approach the green gate for safe handover. We respectfully request that only staff and pupils move beyond this point.

WHAT WILL MY CHILD NEED TO BRING TO SCHOOL?

Your child will need their mid-morning snack and packed lunch if not availing of a canteen meal, a plastic water bottle and a waterproof coat with a hood. All items should be clearly marked with your child's name. Charms and keyrings attached to these items are not

permitted. Pupils should use their blue folder bags and will not require a school bag. New children will receive a folder bag when homework begins.

WHAT ARE THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR HOMETIME?

P1 have been provided with the 'phasing in' home times during the induction process. This begins with P1 children staying until 11am for the first week and increasing in hours each week. Please see your induction letter for this information.
